This site should serve as your checklist, and road map, for all of the to-dos that need to be completed before your start in January. It includes information about advising and registration, housing, student health, and more and will be updated throughout the summer and fall, so please check it regularly.

What's Next?

- **Summer Communications:** To update your contact information for summer communications from the Office of Enrollment Services:
  - 1. Log in to your <u>Emory applicant portal</u>.
  - 2. Scroll down to **Account Tools**, and click on **Change Email Address**.

The Office of Enrollment Services will communicate with you over the next few months regarding your final transcript and college credit (from college courses, AP/IB, etc). Check to make sure we have the correct email address for you now and throughout June and July. This is especially important if you have an email provided by your high school that will expire when you graduate.

• **Housing:** The spring housing application will be available starting October 1 in your <u>MyHousing account</u> and is due on December 1. Housing assignments will become available on or before December 22.

• **Emory Email Account:** You will be receiving important communications to your emory.edu email address throughout the summer and fall regarding required health documents, so be sure to set up your <u>Emory email</u> account now and get in the habit of checking it regularly.

Your Emory email account is part of Office 365, a cloud-based communication system provided to all students. It includes web-based email with 5TB file storage, personal and shared calendars, and much more. Office 365 email can be set up on mobile devices using <u>these instructions</u>.

• **Cars on Campus:** Planning to bring a car to campus? If so, Oxford College requires students to register vehicles parked on campus. Parking registration for the spring semester begins on November 1 and ends December 1. The registration fee is \$125 dollars.

Parking permits are issued on a first-come, first-served basis and must be requested online via the <u>Oxford Parking Application</u>. Do not apply for a permit via the Emory Transportation website. Student parking is available in approved sections of the Fleming parking lot and the Haygood parking lot. Students are not guaranteed parking near their residence hall.

Due to limited parking, students should not bring a vehicle to campus until it has been confirmed that an Oxford College parking permit has been reserved. For questions about parking at Oxford, please email <u>oxford.transportation@emory.edu</u>
